### **Nathan K. Voorhis (ACAS 1997) 1968-2018**

Nathan Voorhis, COO and CRO at AmeriTrust Group, Inc. in Westerville, Ohio, died unexpectedly at the age of 50. He held BAs in both mathematics and education from West Liberty University and an MS in applied mathematics from West Virginia University. He was a member of the American Academy of Actuaries and a former president of the Buckeye Actuarial Continuing Education. Voorhis loved the outdoors and spent much of his time in the woods caring for his land in Ohio. He ran with his wife, and he successfully completed two half-marathons and numerous 5Ks.
